### **HONG KONG AVIATION SECURITY**

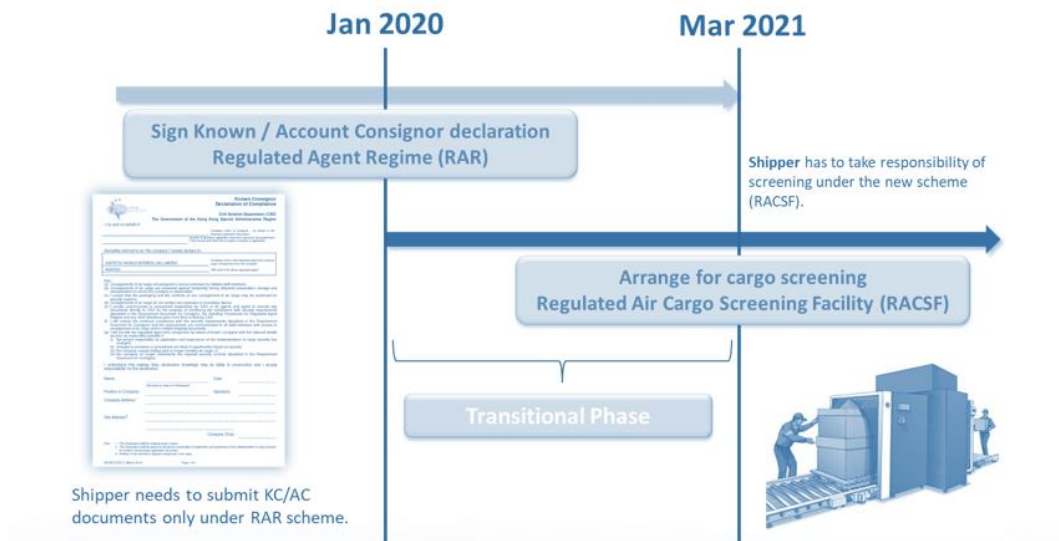
Dear Customers,

In September 2016, the International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO) announced its new policy direction that consignors not subject to approval by the Aviation Security Authority should be phased out by 30 June 2021, while the Hong Kong Civil Aviation Department (HKCAD) has announced the phasing out of the current scheme by 28 Feb 2021.

Under this new policy, consignors will either have to:

- a) be approved by the appropriate authority as a “validated” Known Consignor (KC), or
- b) become an “unknown consignor” with all cargo subject to 100% security screening prior to being loaded on to a commercial aircraft.

## Change in Shipper's Responsibility

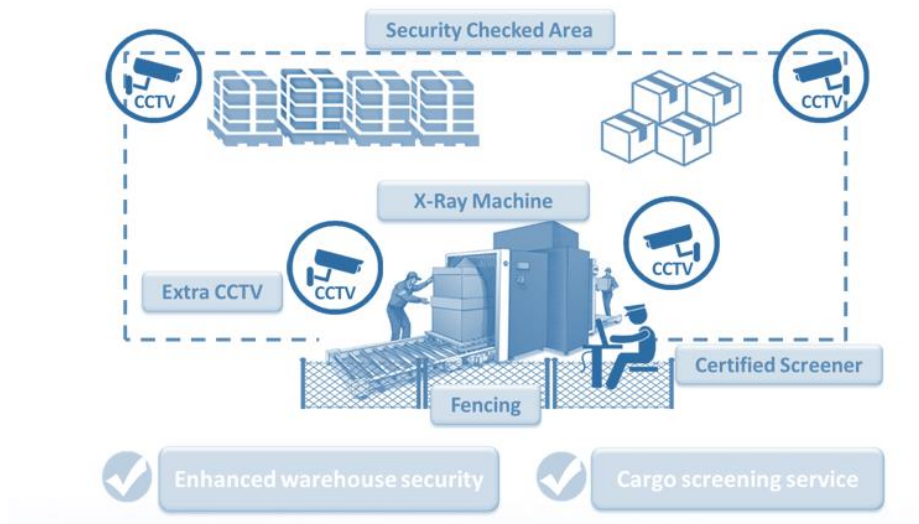

According to the current guidelines of the Hong Kong Civil Aviation Department (CAD), consignors recognized by their partnering Regulated Agents (RAs) may have their consignments treated as known cargo. To comply with the new policy direction, such consignors must either be approved by CAD, or have their air cargo subject to 100% security screening.

### KWE Hongkong as RACSF



In response to the regulations, KWE Hongkong will implement air cargo screening operations in our own premises starting from 1st December, 2019 as an RACSF (Regulated Agent Cargo Screening Facility)

Details :

- Effective Date : 16th December, 2019 (according to day of cargo receiving)
- Applicable shipments : All air export shipments
- RACSF Security Fee : HKD 0.8 per kilogram chargeable weight (Min. HKD 60.00/shipment)
